Stalls Reservations and Assignments: Stalls are \$25/night, 2 night minimum, and can be purchased by going to website www.diamondbararena.com or www.sherrycervi.com and download the *RV & Pen Reservation* form, and mail in with a check. Shavings are \$5.75 per bag, for sale onsite.

After Hours Stall and RV/Hook-Up Check in: There are limited RV hook-ups for \$25.00 a night and can be purchased on the same *RV & Pen Reservation* form and mail in with a check to Diamond Bar Arena. If you are going to be arriving after 9pm, call Diamond Bar Arena 209-538-2704 to make arrangements prior to arrival.

Coggins & Health Certificates: The state of California requires a Health Certificate within 30 days of coming across state lines. Residents and non-residents of California must have a current Coggins as well. Always be prepared to show papers at any time while on the premises.

Warm Up Arenas: Outside Warm Up Arena

Exhibitions / Time Only's: Time-Onlys will be available for purchase at the gate, Thursday, May 23rd 12:00pm- 5:00pm and Friday, May 24th 9:00am-3:30pm. Riders will be allowed 60 seconds and one time through the pattern only.

Drags: Small Drags will occur every 5 riders, and big drags will take place every 30 riders.
